#### 1 Introduction

1.1 This Standard covers mandatory requirements governing identification cards used at Class 1, 2, 3 & 4 facilities.

1.2 This Standard shall be used in conjunction with Security Directive SEC-11 issued by the High Commission for Industrial Security (HCIS), Ministry of Interior, Government of Saudi Arabia. The details of the requirements can be found in SEC-11.

#### 2 Conflicts and Deviations

- 2.1 All conflicts between Standards, Requisitions for Material, related Specifications, Codes, Forms, Drawings and other documents shall be resolved as per <u>SAES-O-201</u>, Section 2.

## 4 General Requirements

Identification cards shall be issued, after proper verification of a person's identity, by a system compliant with the requirements stated in SEC-05. The cards must comply with the following general requirements:

4.1 Card shall be printed on plain feedstock and shall include anti-counterfeiting features, visual authenticators and machine readable data in a smart card format.

- 4.2 Card data shall be encrypted as specified in SEC-11.
- 4.3 Biometrics, when used, shall comply with industry standards.
- 4.4 Cards permitting access to industrial facilities shall be retrieved during personnel vacation unless access to all company facilities use electronic authentication with automatic updates of employees status.
- 4.5 Card designs shall be renewed on a periodic basis.

The specific details of the requirements can be found in SEC-11. This security directive covers applicable industry standards, card design, issue and management.
